

Integration-promoting social services

Integration-promoting social services are intended for persons from 18 to 64 years of age who receive international protection and are in need of social services. The services are intended for immigrants whose home municipality is in South Karelia and who have lived in Finland for less than three years and need assistance in the initial phase of the integration process. We also provide services for victims of human trafficking whose home municipality is in South Karelia.

We support people in a new phase of life and help them move forward. We also help them find the services they need. If necessary, we cooperate with other service providers.

Integration-promoting social services and guidance can include the following:

- assessment of the need for services in accordance with the Social Welfare Act
- systematic social services and guidance
- quidance and counselling related to services and benefits
- supplementary and preventive income support
- support in crisis situations
